

Yr 7 Catch up grant

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium provides schools with an additional £500 for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or Mathematics at the end of key stage 2. Rowhill School has 16 year 7 pupils who meet that criteria. Therefore, Rowhill School received £8,000 funding for the academic year 2013-2014.
