## **Job Description**

We are looking for a Specialist Teacher, with expertise in ASD and SEMH, to work within the Specialist Teaching and Learning Service based at Rowhill Special School in Longfield.

The successful candidate will:

Provide specialist teaching expertise and advice to improve the quality of teaching and learning for children and young people with SEND, supporting the delivery of and access to the National Curriculum and other appropriate approaches to learning.

They will assist in improving practitioner's capacity to raise achievement and attainment of children and young people and overcome the barriers to learning of children and young people with SEND by modelling good practice and developing training, particularly at points of transition

Actively promote the development of an ethos that supports independence and resilience in CYP with SEND.

## Information about the school

The Dartford Specialist Teaching and Learning service is based at Rowhill School (SEMH). The STLS and Rowhill Outreach work closely together to provide support and training to all schools and Early Years settings in the Dartford District. This collaborative working has ensured that CYP with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) in Dartford receive high quality specialist interventions and support to ensure their successful inclusion within mainstream schools and settings.

Access to support for schools and settings is through the Local Inclusion Forum Team (LIFT) and Early Years LIFT process which provides a structure to support schools and settings within the District. This may include individual school support for an identified pupil or groups of pupils, multi-agency working to support children and their families, training for schools and bespoke training for groups of schools.

Rowhill School is a day special school designated for pupils with Social Emotional and Mental Health difficulties. The school currently has approximately 101 on roll between the age of 5 and 16 with a wide range of needs including communication and interaction difficulties as well as behavioural, social and mental health needs

Our staff work closely with pupils to create an ethos of care, respect and success. At Rowhill, we feel strongly that our pupils are entitled to a broad, balanced, inclusive, relevant and learner-focussed curriculum, which will develop the young people to be lifelong independent learners

Rowhill School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the safety and well being of all children and expects all staff to support the school in achieving this commitment.
